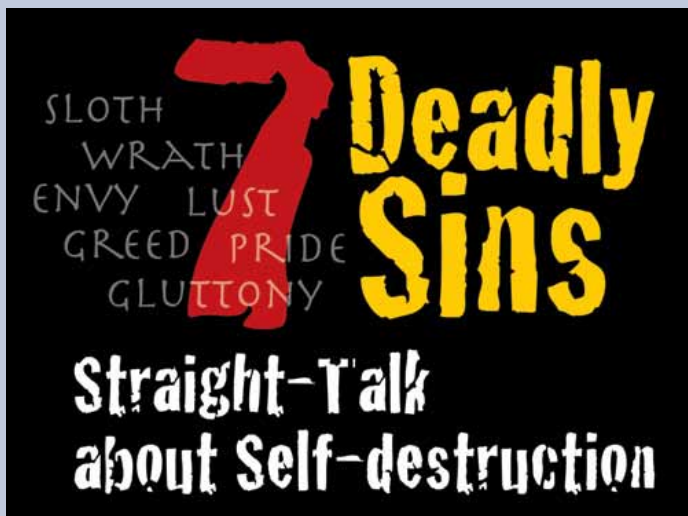

# Season of Lent



For the past several weeks, our congregation has been introduced to a new ministry theme for 2012, entitled, Enter... Experience... Engage. For the most part, our first set of worship themes have been dedicated to the call to ENTER the adventure. We have examined several scriptures wherein many of our forebears in the faith were compelled to respond to the bidding of God into realms of uncertainty and ambiguity through which they would be required to depend upon the Grace of God like never before. Now, as our congregation prepares for the season of Lent, we venture more deeply into the adventure and begin to EXPERIENCE the kind of redemptive and sustaining Grace necessary for the journey.

If Lent is about anything, it is about an EXPERIENCE.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday, and continuing throughout the 40 day journey to Easter Sunday, we embrace the season as a time of introspection and self-examination. During Lent, we invite the Spirit to examine our hearts. We welcome our Lord to reveal to us our own areas of weakness, vulnerability, and sin. Our prayer becomes that of the Psalmist, "Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my thoughts. See if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting." (Ps. 139:23-24) It is only when we are willing to become that vulnerable and transparent with the Spirit that we can fully know the redemptive power of God's grace.

For this reason, I am eager to introduce our next sermon series for the season of Lent. It is called "7 Deadly Sins: Straight Talk about Self Destruction." During this special teaching series, we will learn a bit of history behind the 7 Deadly Sins. We will ask significant questions about them, such as, "Who identified these 7? Why these, and not others? And what is the symbolic significance of them?" But more importantly, we will look closely into the nature of each of the seven,

as a way to understand how the self-destructive power of sin can creep into any of our lives, and prevent us from experiencing the adventure of faith most fully and freely.

Since there are 7 sins to study, and only 6 Sundays in Lent, we will begin our series on Ash Wednesday, February 22, at 6:00 p.m. That night, we will gather in the sanctuary after Family Dinner for a powerful and provocative service of worship. To prepare for each of these lessons and worship experiences, below you will find a schedule of each sermon topic, as well as the corresponding texts that will be studied.

<b>February 26:</b>	<b><i>Greed</i></b> (Prov. 28: 25; Luke 12: 15; Phil. 4: 12 and 2 Cor. 9: 6)
<b>March 4:</b>	<b><i>Envy</i></b> (Gal. 5: 13-23; 6: 2 and Acts 2: 42-46)
<b>March 11:</b>	<b><i>Sloth</i></b> (Matthew 25: 24-25 and 44-45 and John 5: 2-9)
<b>March 18:</b>	<b><i>Gluttony</i></b> (Luke 12: 22-23; Prov. 23: 19-21; John 6: 35; Phil 4: 12)
<b>March 25:</b>	<b><i>Lust</i></b> (1 Thessalonians 4: 3-7; Matthew 5: 27-30)
<b>April 1:</b>	<b><i>Wrath</i></b> (Genesis 4: 1-16 and Romans 5: 6-11 and 12: 17-21)

In addition to our Sunday morning study, our Wednesday night Bible studies will be dedicated to examining the previous Sunday's topic, in greater depth and dialogue.

Make plans now to ENTER the conversation, as we EXPERIENCE the Grace of God together.
