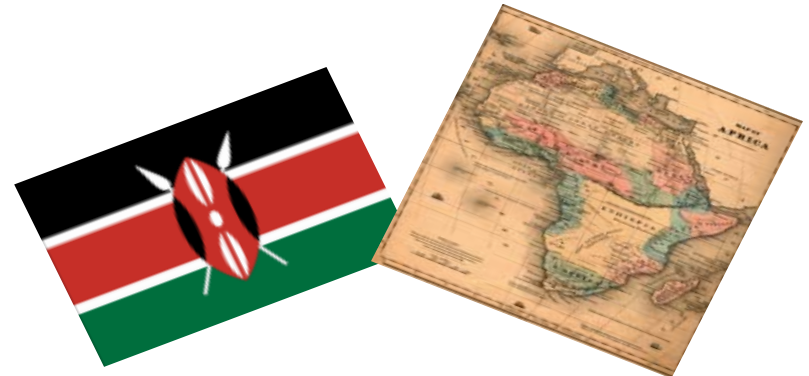

- Sent our first team of 19 members (KP #1) to do Immersion and exploratory ministries in Kenya, and dedicated the bridge we had funded. Some of the team did an exploratory trip into Ethiopia concerning medical needs. This began our interest in extending our involvement to include Ethiopia.

2006:

- Our church funded the building and first year operations of a school/community center in Nakuijit, Kenya.
- Sent a medical team (KP #2) of 13 people to Ethiopia work in the Myungsung Christian Medical Center. Later, 2 members returned to do agricultural projects at the hospital.
- Sent a team of 8 members (KP #3) to Kenya, to minister and dedicate the school at Nakuijit.

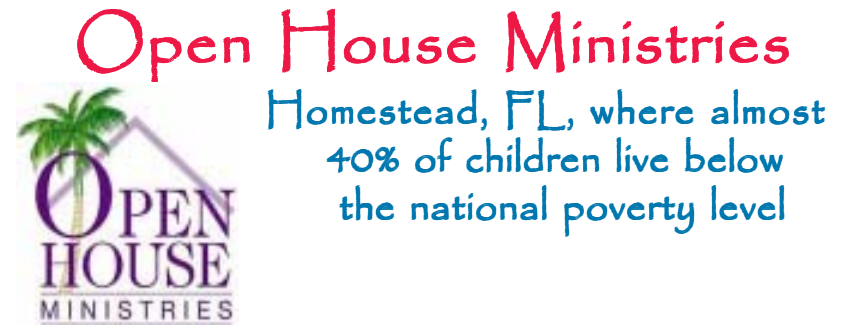
